The Island of Sri Lanka or Ceylon, as it was known till 1972, is situated off the south eastern tip of the Indian subcontinent between the longitudes 80 and 82 degrees east and the latitudes 6 and 10 degrees north. Its maximum length is 432 kilometers from north to south and its maximum width is 224 kilometers from east to west; it has an area of 65,525 square kilometers. Its exclusive maritime economic zone extends over an area of 517,400 square kilometers of Indian ocean.

Arrive in Colombo, the busy capital of Sri Lanka. Overland to Anuradhapura - The capital of Sri Lanka from the 5th Century B.C. to the end of the 10th Century A.D. was the most celebrated of Sri Lanka's ancient ruined cities and Polonnaruwa. Overland to Sigiriya, one of the World Heritage sites and also known as "Fortress in the Sky" which is perhaps the most fantastic single wonder of the Island. Drive further to Kandy, the hill capital and sightseeing tour of Kandy. Explore the Tea Plantation on your way to Nuwara Eliya, one of the biggest tea exporters in the world and finally enjoy the Nuwara Eliya which is also known as The 'Little England' of Sri Lanka, is set against beautiful backdrops of Mountains, Valleys, Waterfalls and Tea Plantations. Descend to the jungles of Yala National Park, before continuing Galle, and enjoy a leisurely walk through the cobbled stone pathways
